Subject: VRX925VD and VRX935VD Parental Codes

Description:

The VRX925VD and VRX935VD have a Parental Lock Code preventing the viewing movies considered inappropriate for younger viewers. This feature can be turned off, allowing for viewing of all movies.

Changing Parental Setting:

- 1) Press and "ADJ" button for 1 second.
- 2) Tap "DVD" on the top menu bar on the screen.
- 3) If a DVD is playing, tap the "STOP" icon on the screen to bring up the DVD Setup menu.
- 4) Tap the "Down Arrow" on the screen to bring up the second page of the setup menu.
- 5) Tap the "Parental Level" icon on the screen.
- 6) Enter the Password Code. (Default code 0000)
 Tap "ENT" icon after Password Code has been entered.
- 7) Tap the Up or Down Arrows to select the Parental Level. (*Default Level 8*) Tap "ENT" icon after Parental Level has been selected.
- 8) Press "RTN" to save selection.
